home values. Plans are also in progress for the opening of the Dollar Tree on the corner of McCartney Road and Woodland.

Since I assumed the duties of Mayor I have had numerous meetings with Eastgate for matching grant funds, the members of the Mayor's Association, Council, Castlo, engineers and other government officials as well as the citizens of Campbell.

I have taken every problem seriously and will continue to do so. I will give all matters, large or small, the consideration needed to resolve them. I believe I have proven to be honest, capable and sincere in my efforts to serve you. Even though my position is part time, I have been a full time Mayor and am willing to dedicate as many hours necessary to accomplish our goals to benefit the city. My office doors are always open.
