

## JUDGE PATRICK P. CUNNING

Dear Citizens of Campbell,

I am running for re-election as your Judge of the Campbell Municipal Court. I was first elected in 2005 and subsequently re-elected to a second term in 2011. I am a lifelong resident of Campbell, Ohio. I graduated from Campbell Memorial High School in 1970. I received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration in 1975 and a Masters Degree in Business Administration in 1977, both from Youngstown State University. I obtained my law degree from the University of Akron in 1983 where I earned the Bancroft Whitney Award as the top ranked student in Torts.

I began my law career at Green Haines Sgambati, Co., LPA in 1983 where I remained, as a partner, until 2013 when I proudly became affiliated with Scullin & Cunning, LLC. I am a member of the Mahoning County Bar Association and the Ohio State Bar Association. I am also admitted to practice in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio.

My wife, Maleen, and I have been married for 41 years. We have four wonderful children and two precious granddaughters. I am an active member of the Campbell Academic Association and the Campbell Gridiron Club. I was active at St. Lucy Church where I served on Parish Council and the Finance Committee as well as being a Lector.



I also procured a technology grant from the Ohio Supreme Court to enhance the court's operation and efficiency. Additionally, I have readily assisted the Police and Fire Departments in alleviating their costs for capital improvements.

I strongly believe in rehabilitation, particularly in the area of substance abuse. As such, I implemented a Probation Services Fund which assists the Probation Department in utilizing the services of professional agencies that provide treatment to those in need.

Most importantly, since taking office I have endeavored to treat everyone who has appeared before me with respect and dignity. I am guided by the principles of honesty, integrity, and justice. I would welcome the opportunity to continue serving the families of Campbell as your Judge and would be honored by your support on November 7.
