

Mark Kolmacic, age 60, married with 3 children and 2 grandchildren, has been a lifelong resident of the City of Campbell. A 1975 graduate of Ursuline High School and a 1979 graduate of Bowling Green State University, Kolmacic obtained his juris doctorate degree from The Capital University School of Law in 1982. He has been engaged in the private practice of law for 36 years and is licensed to practice law in all courts of the State of Ohio including the Federal District Court for the Northern District of Ohio. Kolmacic is a member of the Ohio State Bar Association and the Mahoning County Bar Association. He has previously served 2 terms as the City Director of Law and has prosecuted criminal and traffic matters for the City of Campbell and Coitsville Township.

Kolmacic has also previously sat as acting Judge of the Campbell Municipal Court after having met the educational requirements set forth by the Ohio Supreme Court's Judicial College and has developed a unique perspective from both sides of the bench.

Kolmacic cites courtroom security and the completion of the Court's computerization as areas of particular concern. "Although accessibility is important, security for the Court, it's staff, and the general public, is critical. We live in tumultuous times. Restoring dignity and respect for our system of justice is of utmost importance". Kolmacic pledges to run the Court fairly and effectively, maintaining the decorum necessary to preserve our rule of law. Kolmacic is the son of former longtime Campbell Municipal Court Judge Joseph M. Kolmacic.
